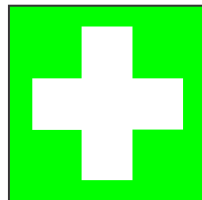

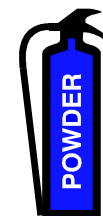
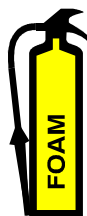
## FIRST AID MEASURES
